Incolink Payments: \$120 per week paid into your redundancy account. Increases to \$140 on 1 October 2022	
Long service leave: 13 weeks after 10 years service, pro rata after 7 years (paid into ColInvest)	
Overtime meal allowance: \$28.53 when required to work overtime for one and a half hours or more on an ordinary working day	
Living away from home allowance: \$815.10 per week, \$160.95 per day

Service Core Allowance			
\$1.60 per hour	For all work carried out in construction of service core. For a period of up to five working days, when Employees working in the service core are required to walk beyond four levels and up to a maximum of six levels, they will be paid double the Service Core Allowance.
