Travel allowance: \$52.50 per day	
Superannuation: \$265 per week, or 10.5% of ordinary time earnings, whichever higher (1 July 2023 increases to \$280 or 11% of ordinary time earnings, whichever higher)	
Incolink Payments: From 1 October 2022 - \$140 per week From 1 October 2023 - \$160 per week, paid into Incolink. Income protection, trauma insurance and portable sick leave are also available (paid into Incolink)	
Long service leave: 13 weeks after ten years service, pro rata after seven years (paid into Colinvest)	
Overtime meal allowance: \$30.81 when required to work overtime for one and a half hours or more on an ordinary working day	
Living away from home allowance: \$880.30 per week, \$173.85 per day	
Additional overnight allowance: \$13.45 per night the employee is required to be away from home.

Service Core Allowance			
\$1.73 per hour	For all work carried out in construction of service core. For a period of up to five working days, when Employees working in the service core are required to walk beyond four levels and up to a maximum of six levels, they will be paid double the Service Core Allowance.		
Altona Area Allowance			
\$1.50 per hour (all-purpose)	For employees within an 8 km radius from the intersection of Kororoit Creek Road and Millers Road, Altona when employed on chemical or petrochemical plants or on industrial construction jobs within 1 km of the nearest part of the perimeter of such plants or within the perimeter of storage tank farms.
