

MAST CLIMBING 36 HOUR WEEK - VICTORIA

Operative from the first full pay period beginning on or after **1 March 2024**.
The following rates of pay represent a **5% wage increase** negotiated by your Union.

	HOURLY RATE	WEEKLY RATE (36 HOUR)
Crane Driver	\$69.36	\$2,496.96
Rigger/Steel Erector	\$65.63	\$2,362.68
Labourers	\$62.04	\$2,233.44

Construction Certificate Allowance

Where work is being performed on metal engineering Construction/installation works, an all-purpose construction certificate allowance of \$70.35 per week from 1st pay period on or after 1 October 2020 shall apply.

This will be paid to all employees classified as Steel Erectors (Crane Driver and Rigger/Steel Erector).

The allowance is in recognition of the multiple ticket and skills requirement required by Steel Erection Employees on metal engineering projects.

Other EBA Benefits include:

Travel allowance: \$54.50 per day.

Superannuation: \$280 per week, or 11.5% of ordinary time earnings, whichever higher

Incolink Payments: \$160 per week, paid into Incolink. Income protection, trauma insurance and portable sick leave are also available (paid into Incolink).

Long service leave: 13 weeks after ten years, pro rata after seven years (paid into ColInvest).

Overtime meal allowance: \$31.98 when required to work overtime for one and a half hours or more on an ordinary working day.

Living away from home allowance: \$913.75 per week, \$180.75 per day

Additional overnight allowance: \$13.95 per night employee is required to be away from home.
