WHEN INJUSTICE BECOMES LAW RESISTANCE BECOMES DUTY


When they passed the ABCC with the help of Senators Hanson, Xenophon and Hinch, the Liberals also passed into law their Building Code.

The Building Code outlaws many clauses in fairly negotiated EBAs. This has the effect of making employers who sign these agreements ineligible for Government Construction work.

The code effectively blackmails companies. They can still negotiate in good faith with employees, and enter into lawful EBAs, but if they do, they will be banned from tendering for lucrative Government construction contracts.

The Liberal's building code is a thinly veiled attack on workers and their conditions.

Before the Federal election in 2016, Malcolm Turnbull made it clear that if elected, he was planning on targetting the wages and conditions of construction workers. In an interview with Alan Jones in the week before the election Turnbull was asked:



"They've secured a 15% pay rise across 3 years with some of Victoria's biggest builders... who is going to stop these excesses?"
