RAVENHALL PRISON: SITE THE SIZE OF AROUND 25 MCGs. 1250 WORKERS ON SITE

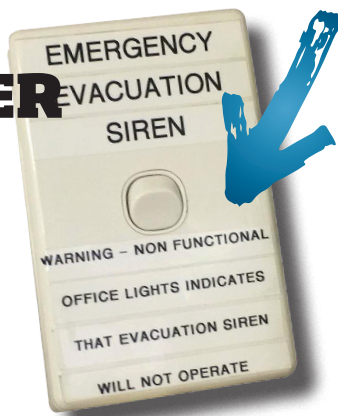
**ONE STRETCHER
