

RIGGER / STEEL ERECTOR 36 HOUR WEEK - VICTORIA

Operative from the first full pay period beginning on or after **1 February 2026**.
The following rates of pay represent a **5% wage increase** negotiated by your Union.

Crane Driver	\$76.47	\$2,752.92
Rigger/Steel Erector	\$72.36	\$2,604.96
Labourers	\$68.40	\$2,462.40

Construction Certificate Allowance

Where work is being performed on metal engineering Construction/installation works, an all-purpose construction certificate allowance of \$70.35 per week from 1st pay period on or after 1 October 2020 shall apply.

This will be paid to all employees classified as Steel Erectors (Crane Driver and Rigger/Steel Erector).

The allowance is in recognition of the multiple ticket and skills requirement required by Steel Erection Employees on metal engineering projects.

OTHER EBA BENEFITS INCLUDE: The following rates of pay begin on/after **1 March 2026**.

Travel allowance: \$57.60 per day.

Superannuation: \$280 per week, or 12% of ordinary time earnings, whichever greater.

Incolink Payments: \$160.00 per week paid into your redundancy account. Income protection, trauma insurance and portable sick leave are also available (paid into Incolink).

Long service leave: 13 weeks after 10 years, pro rata after 7 years (paid into LeavePlus).

Overtime meal allowance: \$33.80 when required to work overtime for one and a half hours or more on an ordinary working day.

Living away from home allowance: \$965.65 per week, \$191.00 per day.

Additional overnight allowance: \$14.75 per night employee is required to be away from home.
